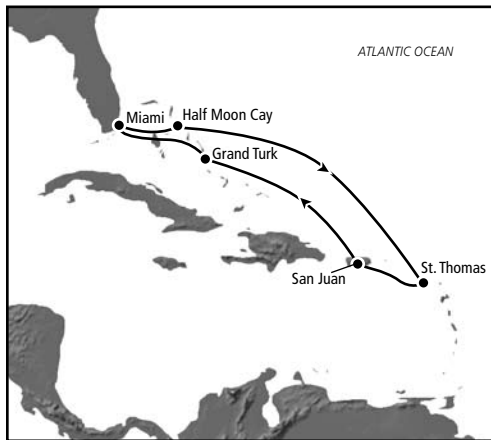


NORTH MASON AERIE AND AUXILIARY 4226 FRATERNAL ORDER OF EAGLES CRUISE
